Benefits of Apprenticeship

- Apprentices are more marketable to employers.
- Earn while you learn.
- Apprentices acquire hands-on skills, knowledge and make contacts for graduate employment.
- Structured on-the-job learning under the mentorship of a journeyperson.
- Apprentices that meet the inter-provincial standard also receive Red Seal Certification and can work throughout Canada where the trade is designated. Both the IE and IMM programs meet this requirement.
- Red Seal programs are eligible for up to \$4000 in grants from Service Canada.
- If you manage your income you complete with no debt

The Apprenticeship Path

- Competency based Training
- As you display proficiency in a skill you complete a portion of the training schedule
- Hired on by an employer
- Register as an apprentice with MTCU
- Join Ontario College of Trades
- Over your employment you complete three levels of College based training
- Complete the training schedule
- Pass the Trades Exam


